Overall Trends

- Wolf Creek Job Corps (WCJC) has not been able to accept new students, which impacts the ABS enrollment and FTE numbers. WCJC hopes to have a full group of students by Fall.
- Dual credit enrollment is up over last year.
- CWT is rebounding after the last two years.
- Undergraduate headcount is down 7.5% but only down 1.5% in FTE.

How Enrollment and Student Services (ESS) Uses the Data

Enrollment Management reviews the term data, as well as the yearly numbers, to help guide new practices in recruitment and retention. Some of these spring to summer strategies include:

- Working to increase the number of dual credit offerings in area high schools to better serve students and impact enrollment.
- Revising Take Flight workshops for the fall to target key areas needed for retention.
- Reaching out to all applicants who have not enrolled from Fall 2021 through Fall 2022 though postcards and texts.
- Almost every high school in the county scheduled in-person advising sessions prior to the end of the academic year.
- Scheduling in-person orientations and Riverhawk Ready days.
- With a series of new grant funded opportunities that include direct student support, the ESS division will work with Marketing to produce outreach materials to be distributed this summer. A number of Career and Technical programs are eligible.

Data Sources:

- FTE data comes from Institutional Research regular enrollment reports
- Enrollment Management tracks Admissions to Enrollment yield and current term enrollment by student declared major. Data is from Banner.

Enrollment and FTE for All Areas of College

The first chart compares Spring Term 2022, Week 9, with Spring Term 2021, Week 9. It details the differences in Total FTE, Reimbursable FTE, Unduplicated Overall Headcount, Unduplicated Credit Headcount, and Registered Credit Hours.
