## Overall Trends-Winter Term

- COVID continues to have a substantial impact. FTE is currently down by 24.4% and credit headcount is down by 8.9%.

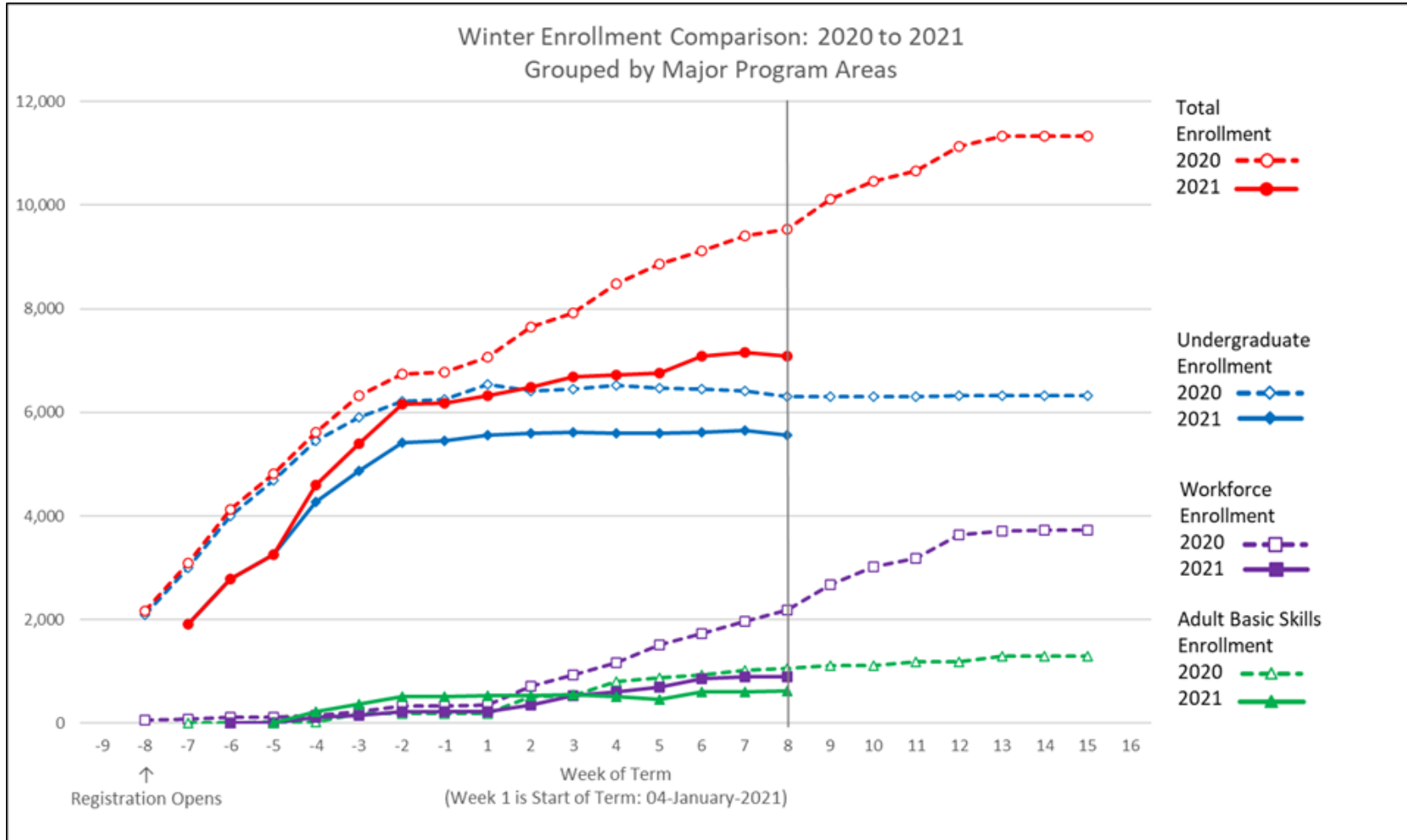
## 20-21 Strategies-Enrollment and Student Services (ESS)

- Admissions calling all students who have applied for admission to verify degree and answer questions on next steps.
- Staff in ESS developed student engagement workshops; hope to expand with new offerings and increased promotion.
- Working on campaign for HS students around personalized assistance on college processes.
- Guided Pathways work included developing clearer Areas of Study to help students decide their path earlier and work with a key advisor.
- Faculty advising has started and will assist with retention efforts.
- Analyzing advising procedures so first time students take writing and math in the first two terms, as well as take 12-15 credits per term.
- Transfer: updated website, application workshops, and developing tracking system for students who do transfer.
- Increase in life coaching sessions; looking at supplemental services to help students

- Enrollment Management tracks Admissions to Enrollment yield and current term enrollment by student declared major. Data is from Banner.

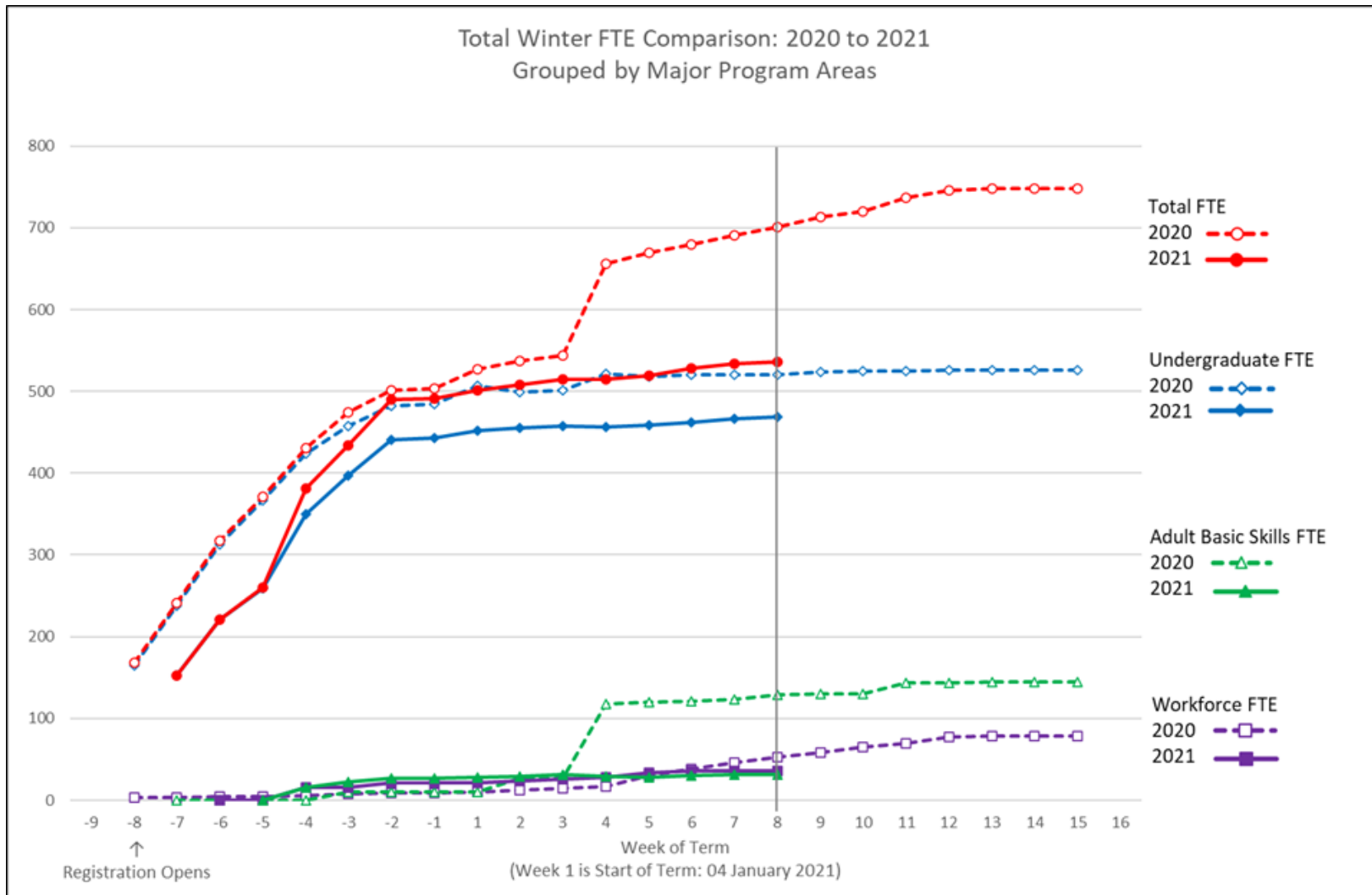
