Class and Conference Health and Safety Guidelines

UCC Community & Workforce Training (CWT) is **requiring** that all students, conference attendees, exhibitors, sponsors, and staff wear a mask while in indoor public spaces, recommends following social distance guidelines wherever possible, and wear a mask outside when social distancing is not possible. This is in effect for all instructors, presenters and attendees, regardless of vaccination status.

CWT is also working to ensure a safe environment including reduced seating capacity, responsible food and beverage placement and distribution, barriers where appropriate, and suggested cleaning policies.

We encourage you to bring your own mask. If needed, UCC will also provide disposable mask.

Your Personal Accountability Commitment

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. By attending a class or event, you voluntarily assume all risks and personal expense related to exposure to COVID-19. As such, UCC requests that **you confirm that you DO NOT** fall into any of the following two categories:

- 1. Currently or within the past fourteen (14) days experienced any symptoms associated with COVID-19, which include fever, cough, and shortness of breath among others.
- 2. Believe that you may have been recently exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 or have been diagnosed with COVID-19.

Accordingly, as an attendee of a class or event we ask that you agree to abide by and engage in certain health-and-wellness beneficial conduct while attending the event. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Wearing a mask if indoors, regardless of vaccination status, except when actively eating or drinking.
- Engaging in appropriate physical distancing.
- Staying home if you do not feel well, have been diagnosed with COVID-19, or had recent exposure to a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case.
