Scholarship and Selection Criteria

- Selection is performed by UCC Community & Workforce office
- Applicants must successfully complete pre-class requirements and enroll in UCC Truck Driving Program before funds are awarded
- Applicants are encouraged to supplement scholarship funds with other training dollars available including South Coast Business, STEP Program, Vocational Rehabilitation or Veteran’s Funding
- Preference shall be given to applicants who are unemployed, underemployed, or show they have overcome hardship circumstances.
- Scholarship funds may be used for UCC Truck Driving Program training fees, including Class A, B and extra driving hours
- Scholarship recipients are expected to respond to requests on where they are currently working after training (for reporting purposes).
