The Bachelor of Science degree requires two courses (7 credits) of math or designated programming, statistics, or logic courses. The second course may be completed at UCC or at SOU. Acceptable UCC courses include: CS161, CS162, MTH105, 112, 211+212, 241, 243, 251, or PH 203

A Bachelor of Arts degree requires the equivalent of one year of study of a foreign language at the second-year level or above. Students seeking a career in criminal justice at the federal level are encouraged to take at least two years of a foreign language.

A maximum of 12 professional/technical course credits may be used towards the degree.

Advising Notes

UCC students who complete the AS degree in Criminology and transfer to SOU will be admitted as pre-Criminology majors. Students will be eligible for full admission to the Criminology and Criminal Justice program after completing the following courses at SOU: CCJ 300 - Essentials of Criminal Justice Research & Writing (4 credits) , with a grade of B- or higher. CCJ 298 - Orientation to Criminology & Criminal Justice (1 credit), with a grade of Pass.

At least two of the science courses must have labs.
