Tuition Deposit Required Before I-20 is Released: Upon receipt of your acceptance letter, direct deposit a minimum of \$4,000 (USA currency) into Umpqua CC's bank account to cover your first term of attendance (tuition & books). Upon completing the Wire Transfer/Direct Deposit, send the receipt by one of the following:

The deposit receipt is required before your I-20 will be released. The receipt will also initiate your student account and guarantee the money will be available for your initial student expenditures.

Expense Details:

- 1. Tuition & Fees: The 2017-2018 International tuition rate is \$228.50 per college credit plus a \$30.00 per term Registration and Insurance fee. The required number of credits to be taken by international students is 12 credits per term. As an international student, you are required to enroll and satisfactorily complete a minimum of 12 credits per term and not recommended to enroll in more than 18 credits per term. There are three (3) terms per year that the student must attend before a term off is available (usually summer).
- **2. Room and Board:** Single bedroom apartments with kitchens in the community are available for approximately \$500-700 per month plus utilities (\$200/mo) (ex: electric, phone, etc.).
- **3. Books and Supplies:** Books are purchased at the beginning of each quarter. If the student is taking one or more sequence courses, the fall quarter books for these courses may be used the entire year. *This is only an estimation.*
- **4. Incidentals:** Incidentals would include pocket money for all expenses other than those listed.
- **5. Transportation:** The transportation calculation is figured at .585 cents per mile for approximately 20 miles per day, five days per week. This would amount to ~\$60 per week for 48 weeks (September June). *This is only an estimation.* Cost may be less if student rides with other students, reimbursing them according to mileage traveled. Limited bus service is also available for Roseburg and outlying towns. Most students drive their own automobiles. Upon request, the International Admissions Office can also assist students in following the procedures for obtaining their Oregon Drivers License.
- **6.** **Insurance: Students must purchase the Health and Accident Insurance offered through the college or provide proof of equal or better health coverage. The amount (\$1464.00) will be charged in the first quarter. If you <u>WILL NOT</u> be purchasing insurance through UCC, provide name of company, policy number & expiration date of the Health & Accident Insurance. <u>Submit a detailed coverage summary</u> outline with application. (Summary must be written in English)
